# Why did we create this power point?

- \* To let staff know how we want to be treated
- \* Council will now be a part of training for new hires and will use this power point to educate the staff
- \* To practice public speaking
- \* Get some points across to our peers
- \* We want people to know we have feelings too
- \* People are aware you can't walk all over us

# What Does Respect Mean To Us?

- \* To listen to what I have to say
- \* Ask me if I need help, don't assume I can't do it
- \* Ask permission
- \* Be polite
- \* Don't yell at us
- \* **If you are going to be late-common curtesy is to call and let the person know and give a time you will be there**
- \* **Know my rights**

# What Does Respect Mean to Us... continued

- \* If a person can't see you, tell them who you are before you enter
- \* Know the person's way they communicate, use it. For example people who use a computer board, staff need to know how it is used and that it's available for the person
- \* Don't use bad words for example: the 'R' word

# What We Expect From You

- \* Treat me like everyone else
- \* Be a good listener, when I am talking to you please make eye contact with me
- \* Think positively
- \* Keep your promises-follow through with what you say you are going to do
- \* To have a nice/easy voice-not over power or threatening

# What We Expect From You- Continued

- \* If I get 'stuck' ask what you can do to help me
- \* Know my support needs
- \* To not **abuse** me

# Who We Want To Work With Us

- \* Staff who are happy when they are talking to you
- \* To be a people person-staff who are on the same page as us
- \* Even if we might be 'crabby' you still have to be nice to us
- \* It is very important to us to have the right match working with us

# In Closing...

- \* Respect and dignity go hand in hand, if we feel respected it then makes you feel more confident
- \* Treat us like humans, we are wonderful people!
